Labcold Inspection and Calibration contracts are designed to ensure single medical and laboratory refrigeration owners can get the same expert service as owners of our certified Medical Device products.

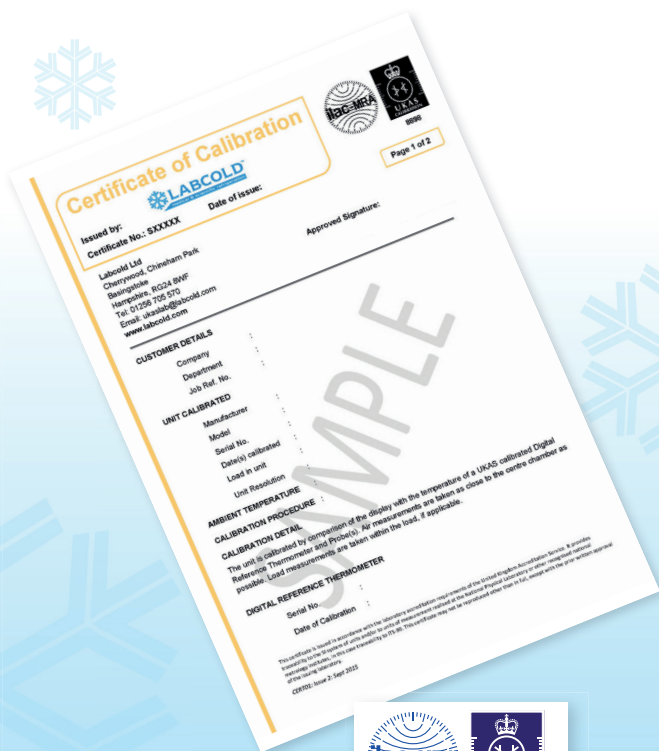

- ❄️ All settings checked and adjusted if incorrect

- ❄️ Thorough inspection for any visible damage

- ❄️ Calibration will be performed to prove that the temperature shown on the display is accurate
- ❄️ A calibration certificate will be issued by our UKAS accredited temperature calibration laboratory #8898
